The City of LaSalle will hold a public meeting on July 30, at 6:00pm, in 745 Second St., LaSalle, IL, City Council Chambers to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed Illinois Open Space Lands Acquisition and Development (OSLAD) Grant project offered through the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about August 19, 2019, The City of LaSalle intends to apply for the Illinois Open Space Lands Acquisition and Development Grant project offered through the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. These funds are to be used for a development project that will include the following activities: expanding Rotary Park with a walk/run path that leads to Prairie Lake. In addition, the grant includes a fishing pier, disc golf, pollinator garden, covered benches, picnic tables, safe shelter/restroom, and picnic pavilion. The total amount of OSLAD grant funds to be requested is \$400,000. The City of La Salle proposes to expend \$402,000 in non-OSLAD funds on the project.
