6. PRIORITY DISPATCH SYSTEM

- a. Director Miller was asked to explain what the DRC (Dispatch Review Committee) was all about and what topics are discussed.

7. OPERATIONAL DISCUSSIONS/GUIDANCE:

- a. Mapping issues-The issues seem to be getting better. There are still a lot of issues with Mendota and Rural locations yet. It's still a work in progress on getting the WTH layers into the new CAD. WTH updates the layers once a month and there are 12 updates sent to Central Square.
- b. Central Square is nationwide and has a shared portal for users.
- c. Livescan Interface is still being worked on.
- d. ProQa determinates are still being built out.
- e. Orientation-Have the most current information on top and having the TC's make sure they are entering the Tell Me Exactly What Happened before they open the discipline. This will be a training thing.
- f. Trespass bans are much better-no new complaints
- g. Duplicated name files for work and personal that was tabled at the last meeting. Agreement to stop separating them and just have one name file.

- h. Ride-A-Longs went well for both dispatchers and officers. Talked about having officers come sit in dispatch.
- i. More race options in the person file. There is a section for Ethnicity where the officers can enter any other race not listed. This needs to stay separated between race and ethnicity for NIBRS.

8. **NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Traffic details have been exploding and some officers are more aggressive than others. ValCom tries to have adequate staffing for these but the officers may be put on Signal 100 if the center gets inundated with calls.
 - i. Chief Raymond advised there is a grant to pay for the cities dispatchers to handle the step-grant traffic.
- b. There have been some issues with officers not putting themselves enroute to a call or telling dispatch they are enroute if they are unable to do it. This causes confusion in dispatch such as wondering if the call went out, if someone is enroute. Same as when officers arrive on scene and clearing the call. If they are not cleared from a previous cad or put into waiting, then goes on another call, everything gets messed up and times are not accurate. Especially when dispatch is busy.
